Whether you are a veteran active teacher, a beginning first year teacher or a teacher whose program has been away from Texas TSA for a while, I would like to encourage you to get involved and have a great 2009 - 2010. We need you to help us seek out new teachers and programs in Technology Education around the State of Texas to get more programs involved in Texas TSA than ever before.
